

CRA Disability Tax Credit T2201: Cover Letter Suggestions

It is recommended that you send in a cover letter with your T-2201 Disability Tax Credit application. To save time, include the following information and requests in the letter:

- 1. Your **Social Insurance Number** and **date of birth**
- 2. Your child's Social Insurance Number and date of birth if applicable
- 3. A request for a reassessment of your income tax returns for the previous ten years, should your application be approved.
 - In cases where the child is under ten years of age, you can make a request for a reassessment back to and including the year of the child's birth.
- 4. A request that, should your application be approved, a copy of the approval be forwarded to the Child Tax Credit division for an eligibility assessment for the Child Disability Benefit.
 - It's usually a good idea to send the CTC a copy of <u>only</u> your cover letter.

Send your application along with your cover letter to your local Canada Revenue Agency office.
